

AMHERST 2ND SOURCE REINFORCEMENT PROJECT

AMP Transmission plans power grid upgrades in Amherst, Ohio. The Project involves expansion of the Amherst #2 Substation to accommodate the new 138/69-kilovolt Woodings Substation and construction of a 0.4 mile 138-kilovolt double-circuit transmission line.



PROJECT COMPONENTS



- New 138/69-kilovolt Woodings Substation
- New 138-kilovolt double circuit power line connecting the Woodings Substation to the existing Beaver-Black River 138 kilovolt (kV) line
- Ohio Power Siting Board project certificate approved

PROJECT BENEFITS



- Improves electric service reliability
- Provides operational flexibility for the Amherst Electric Department
- Supports economic development

DAILY CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE



Construction typically takes place from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.*
*weather permitting

TRAFFIC CONTROL



Limited lane closures on Milan Avenue and North Quarry Road may be required. AMPT will follow all required Maintenance of Traffic plans, when needed.

SAFETY TIPS



- Keep your distance from construction workers and equipment
- Stay outside of temporary safety barriers
- Watch for posted signs

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction Preparation: March - June 2023

- Substation site work
- Strip top soil
- Site grading
- Install perimeter fence

Below-Grade Work: June - August 2023

- Pour concrete foundations
- Drill piers for substation equipment

Above-Grade Work: August - September 2023

- Install substation equipment
- Install substation steel frames

Transmission Line Work: October - December 2023

- Install transmission structures
- Install wires
- Connect substation and transmission lines
- Substation testing
- Energization of Woodings Substation

Post-Construction and Site Restoration: December 2023 - April 2024

- Restore site and install landscaping
